# Overview of the Plan Development Process

- (March-December 2006) A Statewide Needs Assessment: status of CTE in California and opportunities for strengthening the CTE system
- (January-May 2007) Convening of State Plan Resource Group, including representation from all the required stakeholders; three 2-day meetings
- (February, April, August 2007) Review and decisions made by the state's **Joint Advisory Committee on Career Technical Education (JACCTE)**
